We have a long history of successfully integrating international students into our school. Newlands Intermediate School offers a diverse range of educative experiences that enable our students to move on with confidence to Newlands College.

Paramount to successful learning at Newlands Intermediate School is the relationship between the students and teachers. It is based on respect and collaboration. These are attributes that we value.

Core learning

is at the heart of our school. It is essential that Literacy and Numeracy are taught and learnt to a high standard. This is very important to us as they are critical building blocks for student achievement.



We are currently to the forefront of professional development with our staff working on the new curriculum which is being introduced throughout New Zealand by 2010.

Being an Intermediate school we are able to offer a wide variety of subjects. This includes Technology, Languages, ICT and Music. We have specialist teachers and equipment which enable the students to experience the best.

An example of this are our performance groups which are open to all students. Kapa Haka, Poly Club, Brio, Orchestra and Rock Band are hugely popular and recognised throughout Wellington as being at the top level.



All students must take part in our sports programme. Netball, Basketball, Soccer, Rugby, Athletics and Volleyball are just some of the many sports played by our students. All levels of ability are catered for.

Our tuition fees for students enrolling in 2009 are \$10,000. Extra costs for uniform, trips and other items should also be anticipated.

We have a dedicated ESOL (English as a Second Language) teacher on our staff who works with the teachers and students. We are very fortunate to have an extremely close relationship with Newlands College, who are situated next door. We are able to utilise the extra expertise that the College has. This is a very beneficial arrangement as our students go to Newlands College when they finish their two years with us.

All International students who attend Newlands Intermediate School are required to live with a parent or legal guardian whilst attending our school. We do not accept International students who have homestay arrangements.
